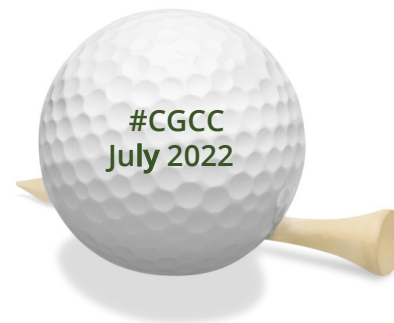

I am sure you have noticed the continued improvement of the condition of the our greens. This is thanks to the Green's Committee members and our green's crew for their efforts. The condition of the greens remains an ongoing area of concern that we will continue to monitor and work to improve.

I can also report that our green's crew is finally fully staffed with two full-time employees and two part-time employees. We have also secured a full slate of mowers to allow the crew to perform necessary functions on a timely basis. We are mindful of areas of need, such as sprinkler repair, water coverage of dry areas, and gopher eradication, and we will continue to address these issues.

The board approved the purchase and installation of cameras for the bar area. Cameras will cover the cash register, bar, liquor storage room, and the exterior doors that allow access to the bar. The system does not record audio and is not Wi-fi connected. It will be accessed by the general manager and house chairman when an issue comes to their attention.

Our membership numbers remain strong, with 290 members, and half-way through our budget year we remain on budget.

Green's Committee Continues Progress

The course has come a long way in the past year and a lot is being done to continue that progress.

- We face a tough summer with the greens. As everyone is aware, we have high salts in the soil and in the water. We didn't get the rain over the winter that typically helps flush the salts, but we will continue on the aggressive nutrition program that helps mitigate the high salts and improve root development and health.
- We have done some major repairs on the wells along with upgrading one that will allow us to be more efficient in our irrigation.
- We have added a new fairway mower to the

fleet and have become more diligent in regular service of the equipment.

- 11 trees have been added to the course with plans to plant more in the fall.
- The green's crew continues to work hard on finding sprinklers that have not been in operation for some time now and repairing them.

Please do not hesitate to contact the Green's Committee with any concerns or ideas that will improve our course. We would also like to encourage anyone able and willing to participate in member workdays. We will announce the next one soon.

Updates from the House Committee

Since the last update, the stucco and painting projects have been completed by our contractors. Currently we are waiting for the exterior roll up door (AC access opening) and some final touch up paint on the exterior piping to call the project complete. Thanks to the members helping with the final touch-ups. The exterior of the building will be done very soon. Now on to the interior!

Due to clogging toilets, the sewer line was replaced from the exterior of the building to the existing septic tank. Thanks to the rapid response of Savage Plumbing, the work was done quickly and under estimate.

The facilities have continued to be very active since our last newsletter. Club events, tournaments, and event rentals continue to keep the club buzzing. Just recently we updated the existing interior surveillance system to a new HD analog closed camera system. The system is video only and cameras are placed to monitor behind the bar area and all the exterior doors. We will look into adding new exterior cameras to this new system, allowing us to have a completely up to date system. We also updated our internet service to Succeed and the difference is incredible. Not only are we experiencing less interruptions and faster speeds, we are also saving an estimated \$150 a month!

In October we requested that our ABC license be expanded to include the fire pit area and new patio/lawn areas. We are happy to report, after a couple in house meetings with the state recently, we are now in the final approval stages. We are hoping this change happens soon so we can enjoy the summer and fall evenings outdoors with a tasty beverage! Again, some things to keep in mind for our members bar to stay in compliance with our ABC license/ABC laws:

No:

- Sales to minors or permitting persons under 21 to consume alcohol
- Minors are allowed to sit at the main bar at any time
- Alcohol from the members bar is allowed outside of the building until the license expansion is complete
- Serving drinks while or to intoxicated persons
- Consumption while working or standing behind the bar
- Serving or consuming alcohol after hours (2am-6am)

Reminder from CGCC Board of Directors

The following rules apply to all areas within the Colusa Golf & Country Club property boundaries. Only members are allowed to utilize the course for dog walking purposes.

- Dogs are not allowed inside any Colusa Golf & Country Club building
- Dogs can be walked on the course during the following hours:
- Mornings: must be off the course by 7:30 am
- Evenings:
 - Summer: can be on the course after 7 pm
 - Winter: can be on the course after 5 pm
- Dogs must be on a leash while on the course
- Owners must carry clean-up bags to pick up after the dog.

- Dogs must be trained and follow commands
- If a dog is brought on the course during hours of play*, the dog must stay on the owner's golf cart
- At any time, the Colusa Golf & Country Club Board of Directors may revoke dog walking privileges on the course if these rules are not followed
- *Summer hours of play: 7:30 am-7 pm
- *Winter hours of play: 7:30 am- 5 pm
